What is being proposed?

The application proposes to create one (1) new lot, for a total of two (2) lots.

The subject lands have a frontage of approximately 33.53 metres (110 ft.) along River Road West, a depth of approximately 46.95 metres (154.04 ft.) along Indianola Crescent, and an area of approximately 1,462 square metres (15,736.84 sq. ft.).

The portion of the lands proposed to be severed, as

shown on the severance sketch provided as 'Part 1' has a frontage of approximately 13.43 metres (44.06 ft.) along Indianola Crescent, a depth of approximately 33.1 metres (108.6 ft.) and an area of approximately 531.6 square metres (5,722.09 sq. ft.).

The portion of the lands proposed to be retained, as shown on the severance sketch provided as 'Part 2' has a frontage of approximately 33.53 metres (110 ft.) along River Road West, a depth of approximately 33.52 metres (109.97 ft.) and an area of approximately 930.4 square metres (10,014.74 sq. ft.).

OTHER APPLICATIONS: The property subject to this application for Consent is not currently the subject of other application(s) under the *Planning Act.*

The legal description of the subject lands is CON 16 PT LOT 7.


The public hearing is your chance to make your views about the proposal known. Information from the public will help the Committee in their decision-making process, so make sure to have your say!

Why Am I Receiving This Notice?
